### March Employee of the Month

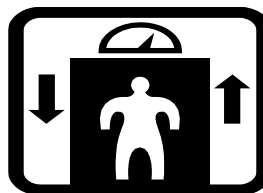
#### David "Dave"

### Elevator Etiquette

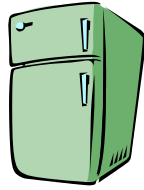

the availability. Remember, do not stand and wait in front of the **fire doors** for the elevator to arrive.

### **Residents Refrigerators**

Dorm size refrigerators are allowed in the apartments if a Refrigerator Possession Agreement is reviewed and signed. Refrigerators must be plugged directly into an electrical outlet. No other appliances used for cooking are allowed in the apartments, including microwaves, coffeepots, etc. Power strips can have no more than six receptacles and must have a UL label. Extension cords are prohibited due to the size of the room and numerous existing electrical outlets. Cooking is not allowed in the resident's apartment. If you do have a Dorm size refrigerator in your apartment please make sure that it is stored off of the floor.

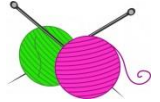
**Thursday, March 2<sup>nd</sup> Wine & Cheese Social**-on the 3<sup>rd</sup> floor common area at 2:30 p.m.
