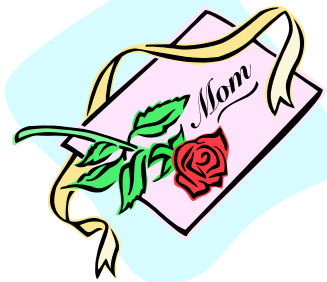

### Veterans Aid & Attendance Benefit

Veterans Affairs provides a Veterans Aid & Attendance for Veterans, Spouses and Surviving Spouses. The Veteran must have Wartime Service (served during war time not that he/she was in combat) and eligibility requirement is based on the need for assistance in activities of daily living such as bathing, dressing, management of medications etc. and financial need. Veterans may be eligible for up to \$1,794 per month and surviving spouses up to \$1,176.00 per month.

Wartime Service Dates:

WWII: 12/7/1941 through 12/31/1946

Korean War: 06/27/1950 through 1/31/1955

Vietnam War: 08/05/1964 through 05/07/1975

Except for Veterans who were in the country of Vietnam from 02/28/1961 through 08/05/1964
