## Libby Bortz Assisted Living Center Pet Therapy Policy

Visiting pets must be healthy, free from fleas and other parasites, and up-to-date on rabies shots and other vaccinations. Be sure to bring printed information on the pet's health and vaccinations if requested by staff.

Pets must be restrained. This means a collar and leash for dogs, and harness and leash for cats.

**The animal handler must have complete control over the animal at all times.**

Be sure to "bathroom" the dog shortly before you enter the facility.

Be certain that the person bringing the pet is able to completely control the animal without assistance from others. A large dog that is not obedience trained, who jumps up on people, or who is not accustomed to walking on a leash, does not make a good visitor. At all times, make sure the pet does not get underfoot in a situation where it could trip a resident.

Please do not leave the pet unattended in the resident's room.

Most importantly, NEVER bring an excitable or nervous pet, or a pet that has ever bitten a human being.
